Treasurer's Report:

Ending balance approximately \$22,119. Haven't received billing from Bear Graphics yet. Al unhappy with the vinyl wall installation, they came back this week and adjusted it. This may be why we haven't received an invoice yet. Also have not received invoices for the break through banner, tent or the gym floor runners. Deducting those expense brings us to \$12,696.54, if we paid out the Student Volunteers that would be an additional \$1476.40 (?) bringing us down to a balance of \$11,217.14.

*Community Hall of Fame balance* = \$2941.41, not all deposits or expenses have been taken out yet. \$1350 for the brick work – this needs to be switched (?). We lose about \$550 per year on the event

Fall Sports Reports:

- Cross Country: Jason Castle- Haileigh Bassett won. She is ranked second in the Regional & 16<sup>th</sup> in the state. Even ranked 14<sup>th</sup>. Boys were 4<sup>th</sup> All League and girls were 7<sup>th</sup> All League.
