#### Treasurer's Report: Kristine- Balance as of 6/30/10 \$24,867.47

- Kristine asked about closing out the student accounts for the 18-19 grads. Question was asked if kids were aware of these funds. All students are aware that funds need to be claimed before graduation.
- Melanie made a motion to close out the student accounts and put the \$200 in the Booster Account. Motion Passed.

#### Athletic Update: Al Margrif

- \$550,000 to update/replace current 6 lane track to an 8 lane track per the school board & their approval of funding.

- There was discussion about which lettering to use. Jason Castle made a motion to use the “White Outline” lettering on the vinyl decal. Second by Melanie. Motion Passed.
- Discussion about “Bronco Tradition” wording on the samples. Mike Snoblen mentioned that he liked “Bronco Pride” because that is what we have said/used for years on pins/banners etc.
- Melanie made a motion that we use “BRONCO Pride” instead of Bronco Tradition on the Vinyl Wall decal in White lettering. 2<sup>nd</sup> and PASSED.

- Melanie also made a motion that we spend up to \$5000 to get Vinyl Wall decal done. 2<sup>nd</sup> and PASSED.
- Boosters would like one of the signs we purchased that says “Another project supported by the NB Athletic Boosters” put up by the Vinyl Wall.

Concessions: We have a new crew taking on the concessions! Yeah!

- Discussion was made that all adult concession workers/volunteers should have backgrounds checks done if they are working with students. AI will look into this.
