Scope will include new dishwasher and new disposer, as well as turn-key installation by factory service technicians.

All sealed bids must be received at the North Branch Educational Services Center, Superintendent's Office, 6655 Jefferson Road, P O Box 3620, North Branch, MI 48461 on or before Tuesday, February 1, 2022 at 2:00 pm (local time). All bids must be in plain envelopes marked "Dishwasher/Disposer Replacement Bid". Proposals received after the designated date and time shall not be accepted or considered. Evaluation of the proposals and awards by the North Branch Area Schools Board of Education will be at a later date.

North Branch Area Schools reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to waive all irregularities in Proposals. Proposals shall remain firm for forty-five (45) days from the date of Bid Opening. A 5% Bid Bond must accompany each submitted bid.
