Treasurer's Report:

Reverse Raffle:

Made \$11,448 profit, which is \$2000 more than last year, and much more than any past year. 2019 Raffle will be last Saturday of February.

Scholarships:

Concessions:

Only 5 home track meets to run concessions for. Teresa Gormley is checking deposits to make sure they are matching financial reports.

Hall of Fame:

There were 10 new nominations this year, and 5 carried over from past years. Committee is meeting this evening to discuss nominations, and will need to meet over summer to finalize ceremony since Homecoming is September 21st.

Queen of Hearts Fundraising:

We are unlikely to continue next year unless we can figure out how to have people purchase online or in bulk somehow.

Track Funding:

Some people are being contacted to see if they can donate \$100,000 for naming rights of our track to help fund renovations. The school is setting aside money every year, but ideally need to move things along.

Record Boards:
